



Captain/Co-Captain Scotch Doubles “Fast 8-Saratoga” Game Rules, Adapted by Jacksonville APA

Jacksonville APA has merged traditional Saratoga game rules with a game called Fast 8 and has adapted the rules to be as consistent with APA game rules as possible, drawing from both the APA doubles and singles formats. Unlike traditional Saratoga, players do not need to call their pocket in this modified version of the game.

- GAME OBJECTIVE – Shoot all of one category in numeric order (lowest to highest), then make the 8-ball to win.
- GAME SETUP – Rack like 9-ball with only balls 1-4, 9-12, and the 8-ball in the middle. The 1 ball must be at the front of the rack.
- AFTER THE BREAK (P. 46-47 of the OTM)
 - APA 8-Ball rules apply concerning which category each team is shooting (take whichever category is made on the break, still open if both are made).
 - APA 9-Ball rules apply concerning which ball to hit (always lowest on the table) and scratching on the break (ball in hand foul from anywhere on the table).
 - Making the 8-on-the-break is not a win, instead the 8-ball is placed on the foot spot and the game continues.
- Must contact the lowest ball of your category (lowest of either category if table is open), including on the break.
- If a ball is pocketed after the incorrect ball was contacted first, then the pocketed ball is spotted before the next player shoots.

All other APA 8-Ball, 9-Ball, and Doubles rules apply, and are available in the APA Official Team Manual which can be downloaded at poolplayers.com or by scanning this QR code.
